



Kramer Conflict Minerals Policy

The Responsible Business Alliance, originally called the Electronics Industry Code of Conduct, continues to grow and evolve in conjunction with the expanding role electronics companies like Kramer, play in our modern world.

One of the key areas of concern for Kramer is the exploitation of natural resources on the African continent, especially the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), where revenue from illicit mineral mining has been used to fund groups engaged in acts of violence and human rights atrocities.

To combat this issue, Kramer has implemented an internal due diligence program based on the Responsible Business Alliance and the Responsible Minerals Initiative. The program employs a data collection system across the supply chain for the purpose of gathering and disclosing information on the providers of 3TG minerals (tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold) with the goal of ensuring conflict-free Sourcing.
