Goals

Rea Sound AV was tasked with transforming the Cregagh Presbyterian Church into a seamlessly integrated and technologically advanced space, in the most cost-effective manner.

The objective was to implement a user-friendly control system that would enhance the church's audio-visual capabilities, while integrating smoothly with its existing infrastructure. As a multi-building, multi-story complex, with varied spaces, the church needed the system to be very flexible, capable of supporting different spaces and meeting varying needs. The goal after all, was to facilitate an immersive and captivating experience for both inperson and remote church attendees, and participants in different parts of the complex. This demanded cutting-edge technology, but it was also important that the solution match the church aesthetic.



Solution

After assessing the church's needs, it was clear the existing infrastructure could not meet the new requirements. So, Rea Sound devised a comprehensive solution to address immediate challenges, and provide a reliable and efficient control system for future needs.

This started with the selection of Kramer Control. A customized Kramer SL-240C room controller now serves as the central control unit, running Kramer Control. Multiple Kramer KDS-EN7 AVoIP encoders distribute signals to displays and projectors, while KDS-DEC7 decoders handle input sources. AV signals are transmitted over IP, using NETGEAR AV Line Managed Switches.
